The Prostate Cancer Foundation, PCF, was founded in 1993 to find better treatments and a cure for prostate cancer. Prostate cancer is still the most commonly diagnosed non-skin cancer in America with a new case diagnosed every 3 minutes (192,000 per year) and a life is lost every 19 minutes (over 27,000 per year) to this disease.

Through its unique model for soliciting promising research programs and rapid deployment of resources, the PCF has funded more than 1,500 programs at nearly 200 research centers in 20 countries around the world. The PCF is a force of HOPE for more than 16 million men and their families around the world who are currently facing this disease. By participating in this year's Atlanta Area Drive for the Cure, you will be helping the PCF support ongoing research.

Since its inception, this tournament at the Country Club of Roswell has generated over \$370,000 for prostate cancer research.
